

Alpha & Omega Home



The Alpha and Omega Home is an outreach ministry of Whosoever Will Praise and Worship Center. The purpose of Alpha & Omega Home is to provide a Christian Recovery Program to help men break their drug/alcohol addiction. We offer an intense eight week Bible teaching and mentoring ministry for men bound by the chains of addiction. During the eight week stay at Alpha & Omega Home the men complete Bible Studies consisting of twenty-three CD's and seven books. The men are also required to attend daily Chapel services each morning and each afternoon. In addition to completing Bible Study assignments and attending Church service each week the men participate in other activities offered by Whosoever Will Praise and Worship Center. Some examples of activities include Gospel Sings, Church Celebration, Men's Fellowship, Celebrate Recovery, etc...

Our overall mission is to lead men who are troubled by addictions to a lasting personal relationship with Jesus Christ. This relationship with Christ will allow the men to overcome their addictions and become the person God intended them to be. As our name states, we are committed to new beginnings and the ending of our past sinful ways. To transform men addicted to alcohol and drugs we understand change does not take place simply because of a social program, but through the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God. It takes the Holy Spirit changing us and transforming our lives in order to break the chains of addiction. This ministry is strictly a Christian-based and during the eight week program the men will be required to attend various church services and activities. The men of Alpha & Omega will also be taught

leadership and life skills during their stay at the Alpha & Omega Home. The program is for men who are tired of being an addict and really desire a change in their life. After eight weeks the men who complete the Alpha & Omega Home program requirements graduate and are given a certificate.
